Latvia is a country on the Baltic Sea between Lithuania and Estonia. Its landscape is marked by wide beaches as well as dense, sprawling forests. Riga is home to notable wooden and art nouveau architecture, a vast Central Market and a medieval Old Town with St. Peter's Church. Riga's museums include the Latvian Ethnographic Open-Air Museum, showcasing local crafts, food and music.



HOW TO GET THERE

BY AIR

Visitors can fly to Riga International airport from all major cities in Europe.

Distance from golf course: ~12 km

BY SEA

Visitors can arrive by ferry to Ventspils and Liepāja and take a bus/car from Ventspils and Liepāja to Riga/Jurmala. The route A9 leads from Liepāja, while route E22 connects Ventspils to the destination.

BY ROAD

Several national roads start in Riga and the Via Baltica. European route E67 crosses Riga from the south and north. The city is 300 kilometers from Tallinn, Estonia, and 260 kilometers from Vilnius, Lithuania.

BY BUS

Several international bus lines, such as Eurolines, Ecolines and LuxExpress, run from Riga International Bus Station to Denmark, France, Germany, Norway, Poland, Sweden, Finland, Estonia and Lithuania.


